Ocean Adventurer 2 is a Nautitech 82 power catamaran.

The vessel has a top speed of 21 knots, cruising speed of 12-14 knots, and boasts a range of 3000nm at cruising speed.

There are 4 cabins, 3 doubles and 1 cabin with 4 bunks.



Double cabins can be split for singles with dividers if required



The yacht is well appointed, with electric heads and hot showers.

2 x 5,2 m tenders with 40hp and 25hp outboards
Gas BBQ
Fuel consumption:
8knots = 1,5 liter per nautical mile
12 knots = 2-2,5 liters per nautical mile
20 knots = 5 liters per nautical mile.
