With twin Yanmar 40hp diesels fitted in separate engine rooms she is just as powerful under motor.


She is currently based between Dar es Salaam, Zanzibar, Pemba and Mafia Islands.

All modern electronics and Safety gear are standard as per SAMSA Category 1 Offshore requirements




**Safety Equipment**

The cabins have a light airy interior, ample deck and side hatches as well as Hella fans for ventilation.


There is plenty of storage and hanging space with cherrywood trim throughout.

Between the trampolines she has a drop down aluminum boarding ladder for easy on and off beach access




